

The NSF Site Visit is a term and condition of the ADVANCE grant. The site visit includes a day and a half of meetings and a half day of reporting by the site visit team. The site visit is comprised of 8 visitors, 6 evaluators with relevant content expertise and 2 NSF staff members. A presentation on program initiatives and progress is made on the first day by the ADVANCE-Nebraska team. The interviews will include individual as well as group sessions. The interviews and evaluations are meant to assess project performance and progress to date as well as to provide feedback to the project.
